A selection of wine and Italian small plates at this new trattoria, just steps away from the Pearl district.

The Scene

Set in a subterranean corner spot with lots of light, diners are greeted by a spare, modern space highlighted by a gleaming open kitchen. Dark walls and a granite bar are set off by crisp white tablecloths. The staff is efficient but seems unacquainted with the large, by-the-glass wine selection.

The Food

The Italian-inspired menu consists of 30 or so smallish plates at reasonable prices for the sip-and-nibble crowd. For a great light meal, order several starters--like the crisp cauliflower or baccala (dried salt cod) fritters, thick grilled bruschetta with a long list of toppings, or the excellent grilled pizza topped with prosciutto and pesto. The more substantial plates tend to be less charming, particularly the bland clams in a white wine saffron broth and the overcooked, tough pork chops. Concentrate on small plates and the fun, fascinating wine list for a good nosh.
