Every month Vitis will feature a new artist, and the artist will visit Vitis on the First Thursday of the month. During First Thursday, hundreds of people walk from art gallery to gallery, sipping wine and meeting local artists. At Vitis we decided to kick it up a notch and offer dinner alongside art, wine and meeting the artist. Tedd remembers from his early childhood that he always had the passion to paint. His training is from art classes in college, architectural rendering classes and personal

study. Ten years ago, when computers started taking over his architectural practice he experienced what he calls "Graphite Withdrawal." After sketching eight hours a day for twenty years then switching to sitting in front a monitor and moving only a mouse he found the need to express his artistic skills and began painting watercolors & oil paintings. His studies have included workshops with Arne Westerman, Susan McKenna, Barbara Nechis, Ryan Wurmser, Nelson Shanks and Xhaoging Zhu, and his paintings have been exhibited with local galleries' "Group Shows" and with the Watercolor Society of Oregon shows.

A recent review of his artwork: "It's very thought provoking and your paintings makes one wonder 'what' is going on in this person's mind."

Winemaker Dinner

Vitis Enoteca is hosting its first in a new series of Winemaker Dinners at its Pearl District space. The pan-Italian restaurant has invited new Oregon winery, Dalla Vina, to present its wines, accompanied by Vitis' signature Italian cuisine. Each dish will be accompanied by a different varietal of Dalla Vina, with a description and talk by Dalla Vina winemaker, Karl Dinger. All four of the winery's wines will be featured during the winemaker



dinner, including the inaugural 2004 vintages of Columbia Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Syrah, and a red Bordeaux-style blend called Bella Vista Red. Each diner will get samples of the wines with specific dishes from Vitis Enoteca. Dinner will begin at 6:30 pm on February 21st; cost per person is \$60. Please call 503-241-0355 for reservations.
